SUBJECT: U.S. Army Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) and Technical Assistance for Public Participation (TAPP) Guidance

This guidance applies to active, excess, Army Reserve, National Guard Bureau (NGB), and Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC) installations conducting environmental restoration activities under the Army Defense Environmental Restoration Program (DERP).
